Company and School

Chattanooga Ballet is recognized as one of Tennessee's leading dance organizations.

Founded in 1973, the School principally focuses on the instruction and training of dancers in classical ballet with offerings in ballet technique, pointe and variations. Supplemental classes are offered in Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet, Yoga, Pilates, Jazz and Modern technique. Former students have gone on to perform professionally in New York, Chicago, Atlanta, Birmingham, San Francisco and Washington, D.C.

Begun in 1980, the Company is composed of professional dancers and advanced level students. The Company performs both classical and contemporary works and seeks to enhance the quality of dance in our region through the commissioning of new works in ballet, jazz and modern dance. The Company presents an annual production of The Nutcracker with the Chattanooga Symphony and Opera Orchestra, a choreographer's concert, classical ballets, lecture demonstrations and school performances.

The Chattanooga Ballet Children's Company is the training company of the Chattanooga Ballet School. It is comprised of Intermediate 2 level dancers and above who have reached a higher level of technique and commitment. The Children's Company is designed to give a few more hours per week to their dancing. Children's Company members are featured in Chattanooga Ballet concerts as well as community service and collaborative performances with other local arts organizations.



Chattanooga Ballet is a 501(c)(3) organization and is funded by Arts Build, the Tennessee Arts Commission, The National Endowment for the Arts, corporate grants, and individual contributions.



Curriculum

All prices listed are per 10 week term. Please check the calendar for a complete list of term dates and registration deadlines.

Please note: all placement decisions are made at the discretion of the faculty with the student's best interest in mind. Students must complete all three terms at their level in order to advance to the next level.

<u>Level</u>	<u>Age/Prerequisite</u>	<u>Price</u>
Creative Movement	3 & 4 year olds	\$95.00
Creative Movement is a great introduction to the world of dance designed especially for 3 & 4 year olds. Students will begin learning basic ballet positions and steps and will work to develop balance, coordination, and rhythm. Through the use of structured games and activities, each class will allow students to explore different ways of moving.		
Pre-Ballet	5 & 6 year olds	\$100.00
Pre-Ballet is perfect for 5 & 6 year olds who have already completed Creative Movement or who are new to ballet. Students will learn basic ballet steps and terminology while continuing to develop balance, coordination, flexibility and rhythm.		
Grade 1	7 to 10 year olds	\$115.00
Grade 1 Ballet is for 7 to 10 year olds who is interested in ballet and wants to get moving! In addition to learning new steps and terminology, dancers will begin to focus on correct technique and alignment.		
Grade 2	Three terms of Grade 1 or the equivalent	\$115.00
Grade 2 Ballet emphasizes proper placement, alignment, and execution of basic technique.		
Grade 3	Three terms of Grade 2 or the equivalent	\$185.00
Grade 3 Ballet is designed for ballet students who are up for a challenge and who are ready to spend more time at the studio. Dancers will take two classes per week and will continue to focus on the proper execution of basic technique.		
Grade 4	Three terms of Grade 3 or the equivalent	\$185.00
Grade 4 dancers will further develop technique while working to improve strength, balance, and flexibility.		
Intermediate 1	Three terms of Grade 4 or the equivalent	\$200.00
Intermediate 1 continues to expand movement vocabulary. Students will begin developing the strength, balance, and control necessary for pointe work.		
Intermediate 2	By instructor's permission	\$220.00
Intermediate 2 is open to the serious student who is working to develop the skills necessary for pointe work and performance. Training increases to three days per week. Dancers at this level are eligible to audition for the Children's Company.		
Intermediate 3	By instructor's permission	\$220.00
Intermediate 3 students work to expand movement vocabulary and begin to focus more on pointe work.		
Intermediate 4	By instructor's permission	\$220.00
Intermediate 4 helps students make the transition to the Advanced level. Students are strongly encouraged to take an additional ballet class per week and/or the Modern class.		
Advanced	By instructor's permission	\$250.00
Advanced level dancers are required to attend 4 classes per week. Dancers are strongly encouraged to register for the Modern class in addition to regular ballet classes.		
Teen & Adult Ballet I & II	Ages 13 and up	\$115.00 1 cls/week \$185.00 2 cls/week
It's never too late to get started! Teen & Adult Ballet is a great introduction to ballet or refresher course for those who took ballet years ago. While learning basic ballet technique, students will work to improve flexibility, coordination, and strength.		
Modern	Ages 13 and up	\$110.00
Modern explores and introduces students to the many modern dance techniques of today.		
Boys Class	Ages 7 to 12	\$110.00
Boys Class is a ballet class specifically designed for boys. Students will learn ballet terminology while developing balance, coordination, flexibility, and rhythm. This is a great class for boys to prepare for participation in <i>The Nutcracker</i> , continue their ballet studies, and sports.

Location

Chattanooga Ballet's home, The William L. Montague, Jr., Center for the Dance is located at 817B North Market Street. From the corner of the Market Street Bridge & Frazier Avenue, head north on Market Street (away from downtown). Go for approximately 0.75 miles. Turn left on Peak Street. At the first stop sign turn right onto North Market Street. Chattanooga Ballet is located one block ahead on your left. Free parking is available in the lot behind the facility.

Dress Code

- Pre-ballet through Advanced level girls should wear a simple tank-style leotard in their class color, pink footed tights and pink ballet slippers. Hair must be secured in a bun. Jewelry, skirts, tutus, warm-ups and other clothing is not permitted in the studio.
 - Creative Movement girls should wear a plain white leotard and pink ballet slippers. Pink footed tights are optional.
 - All boys should wear black shorts or tights, a white t-shirt, and black ballet slippers.
 - Teen & Adult Ballet students should wear any solid color leotard and tights or exercise clothing and ballet slippers.
 - Modern students should wear a solid color leotard and black footless or convertible tights.

Late Registration Policy

Tuition must be paid prior to the first meeting of class. Late registration is subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

Class Miniums

Class minimus are set at eight students. If the minimum is not met, classes may be cancelled or combined with another class.

Refund Policy

Withdrawal by the student between the first and second class is subject to a \$7.50 cancellation fee. There is no refund for cancellation by the student after the second class regardless of attendance.
